Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be
8	necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
9	Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, and allocated in a manner
10	as determined by the Treasurer's Office, to the Mississippi
11	Department of Public Safety for the purpose of purchasing eligible
12	equipment for law enforcement officers employed by and through the
13	Mississippi Department of Public Safety for the period beginning
14	from and after the passage of this act and ending June 30, 2025
15	\$ 0.00.

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16 SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section and Section 3 of 17 this act, the term "department" means the Mississippi Department 18 of Public Safety.

The department shall not disburse any funds appropriated 19 (2)20 under this act to any recipient without first: (a) making an 21 individualized determination that the expenditure sought is, in 22 the department's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as 23 24 added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 25 2021 (ARPA) and its implementing guidelines, guidance, rules, 26 regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or 27 supplemented from time-to-time, by the United States Department of 28 the Treasury and (b) determining that the recipient has not 29 received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in 30 question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds, 31 other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal 32 Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. In addition, the department shall ensure that all funds appropriated 33 34 under this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit 35 Act (31 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the 36 Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal controls, Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding sub-recipient 37 38 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit

39 requirements.

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SECTION 3. 40 (1) As a condition of receiving and expending 41 the funds appropriated to the department under this act, the department shall certify to the Department of Finance and 42 43 Administration that each expenditure of the funds appropriated to 44 the department under this act complies with the guidelines, 45 quidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be 46 amended from time to time, of the United States Department of the 47 Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus State 48 Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA.

49 If the Office of Inspector General of the United States (2)50 Department of the Treasury or the Office of Inspector General of 51 any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies 52 from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by 53 ARPA (a) determines that the department or recipient has expended 54 or otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the department 55 under this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the 56 quidelines, quidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as 57 may be amended from time-to-time, of the United States Department 58 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus 59 State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA and (b) the State 60 of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any 61 of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined were expended or otherwise used improperly by the department or 62 63 recipient, then the department or recipient that expended or otherwise used those funds improperly shall be required to pay the 64

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65 amount of those funds to the State of Mississippi for repayment to 66 the federal government.

67 The money appropriated by this act shall be paid SECTION 4. by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State 68 69 Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants 70 issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his or her warrants upon requisitions signed by the 71 72 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 73 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 74 and after its passage, and shall stand repealed on the day before 75 its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT 2 OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING ELIGIBLE EQUIPMENT 3 FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS EMPLOYED BY AND THROUGH THE 4 MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING 5 UPON THE PASSAGE OF THIS ACT AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2025.
