- 1 AMEND by striking Section 1 on lines 6 through 12 in its 2 entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 3 **SECTION 1.** Section 23-15-563, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 4 amended as follows:
- 5 23-15-563. (1) Each person who appears to vote in person at
- 6 a polling place or the registrar's office shall be required to
- 7 identify himself or herself to a poll manager or the registrar by
- 8 presenting current and valid photo identification before such
- 9 person shall be allowed to vote.
- 10 (2) The identification required by subsection (1) of this
- 11 section shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
- 12 (a) A * * * valid Mississippi driver's license;
- 13 (b) A * * * valid identification card issued by a
- 14 branch, department, agency or entity of the State of Mississippi;

- 15 (c) A * * * valid United States passport;
- 16 (d) A * * * valid employee identification card
- 17 containing a photograph of the elector and issued by any branch,
- 18 department, agency or entity of the United States government, the
- 19 State of Mississippi, or any county, municipality, board,
- 20 authority or other entity of this state;
- 21 (e) A current and valid Mississippi license to carry a
- 22 pistol or revolver;
- 23 (f) A valid tribal identification card containing a
- 24 photograph of the elector;
- 25 (g) A * * * valid United States military identification
- 26 card;
- 27 (h) A current and valid student identification card,
- 28 containing a photograph of the elector, issued by any accredited
- 29 college, university or community or junior college in the State of
- 30 Mississippi; and
- 31 (i) An official Mississippi voter identification card
- 32 containing a photograph of the elector.
- 33 (3) For purposes of this section valid shall mean an
- 34 official government document that establishes the voter's identity
- 35 and has no expiration date or has an issuance date not more than
- 36 ten (10) years prior to the date the document is presented.
- 37 (* * *4) (a) A person who appears to vote in person at a
- 38 polling place and does not have identification as required by this
- 39 section may vote by affidavit ballot. The affidavit ballot shall

- 40 then be counted if the person shall present acceptable photo
- 41 identification to the registrar within five (5) days.
- 42 (b) An elector who has a religious objection to being
- 43 photographed may vote by affidavit ballot, and the elector, within
- 44 five (5) days after the election, shall execute an affidavit in
- 45 the registrar's office affirming that the exemption applies.
- 46 (* * *5) The intentional failure of an election official to
- 47 require a voter to present identification as required by this
- 48 section shall be considered corrupt conduct under Section 97-13-19
- 49 and shall be reported to the Secretary of State and the Attorney
- 50 General.
