HOUSE BILL NO. 122

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE SPECIFIED 2 INFORMATION TO CERTAIN PARENTS OR STUDENTS ON THE IMPORTANCE OF 3 WATER SAFETY EDUCATION COURSES AND SWIMMING LESSONS; TO REQUIRE THE INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED ELECTRONICALLY OR IN HARD COPY AND 5 INCLUDE LOCAL OPTIONS FOR AGE-APPROPRIATE WATER SAFETY COURSES AND 6 SWIMMING LESSONS THAT RESULT IN CERTIFICATION INDICATING 7 SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION; TO DEFINE THE TERM "WATER SAFETY"; AND FOR 8 RELATED PURPOSES. 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. (1) For the purposes of this section, the term

- 11 "water safety" means age-appropriate education intended to promote
- safety in, on, and around bodies of water and reduce the risk of 12
- injury or drowning. 13
- 14 (2) Beginning with the 2025-2026 school year, each public
- 15 school shall provide, to a parent who initially enrolls his or her
- 16 child in the school, information on the important role water
- safety education courses and swimming lessons play in saving 17
- lives. The information must be provided electronically or in hard 18
- 19 copy and must include local options for age-appropriate water
- 20 safety courses and swimming lessons that result in a certificate
- indicating successful completion, including courses and lessons 21

- 22 offered for free or at a reduced price. If the student is
- 23 eighteen (18) years of age or older, or is under the age of
- 24 twenty-one (21) and is enrolling in adult education classes, the
- 25 information must be provided to the student.
- 26 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2025.
