HOUSE BILL NO. 570

- AN ACT TO REQUIRE GOVERNMENTAL BODIES THAT EMPLOY OR CONTRACT FOR FULL-TIME CERTIFIED EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS (EMTS),

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Each governmental body that employs or contracts
- 9 for full-time emergency medical technicians (EMTs), paramedics or
- 10 emergency medical responders (EMRs) who are certified by the State
- 11 Department of Health, and each governmental entity that employs or
- 12 contracts for full-time firefighters who are certified by the
- 13 Mississippi Fire Personnel Minimum Standards and Certification
- 14 Board, shall provide Mental Health First Aid training that is
- 15 evidence-based and approved by the Department of Mental Health to
- 16 all of those personnel by July 1, 2031.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2025.
