HOUSE BILL NO. 601

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-15-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MISSISSIPPI BOARD OF NURSING TO REMOVE THE LICENSED PHYSICIAN MEMBER AND ADD A CERTIFIED REGISTERED NURSE ANESTHETIST MEMBER; TO PROVIDE THAT THE MEMBERS 5 OF THE BOARD WHO ARE REGISTERED NURSES OTHER THAN THE NURSE 6 PRACTITIONER MEMBER AND THE CERTIFIED REGISTERED NURSE ANESTHETIST 7 MEMBER SHALL NOT BE ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSES; TO DELETE THE REQUIREMENT THAT MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL BE APPOINTED FROM 8 9 LISTS OF NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY MISSISSIPPI REGISTERED NURSE AND 10 PRACTICAL NURSE ORGANIZATIONS OR ASSOCIATIONS; TO AMEND SECTIONS 73-15-11 AND 73-15-15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM TO THE 11 12 PRECEDING PROVISIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 14 **SECTION 1.** Section 73-15-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 15 16 73-15-9. (1) There is \star \star created a board to be known as 17 the Mississippi Board of Nursing, composed of thirteen (13) 18 members, two (2) of whom shall be nurse educators; three (3) of whom shall be registered nurses in clinical practice, two (2) to 19 20 have as basic nursing preparation an associate degree or diploma 21 and one (1) to have as basic nursing preparation a baccalaureate 22 degree; one (1) of whom shall be a registered nurse at large; one 23 (1) of whom shall be a registered nurse practitioner; four (4) of

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- 24 whom shall be licensed practical nurses; one (1) of whom shall be
- 25 a * * * certified registered nurse anesthetist; and one (1) of
- 26 whom shall represent consumers of health services. The members of
- 27 the board who are registered nurses other than the nurse
- 28 practitioner member and the certified registered nurse anesthetist
- 29 member shall not be advanced practice registered nurses. There
- 30 shall be at least \star \star \star two (2) board members from each \star \star
- 31 Supreme Court district in the state; * * * however, * * * the
- 32 consumer representative member and one (1) registered nurse member
- 33 shall be at large always.
- 34 (2) Members of the Mississippi Board of Nursing * * * shall
- 35 be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the
- 36 Senate * * *. Appointments made to fill vacancies for unexpired
- 37 terms shall be for the duration of such terms and until a
- 38 successor is duly appointed.
- 39 (3) Members of the board shall be appointed in staggered
- 40 terms for four (4) years or until a successor shall be duly
- 41 qualified. No member may serve more than two (2) consecutive full
- 42 terms. Members of the board serving on July 1, 1988, shall
- 43 continue to serve for their appointed terms.
- 44 (4) Vacancies occurring by reason of resignation, death or
- 45 otherwise shall be filled by appointment of the Governor * * *.
- 46 All vacancy appointments shall be for the unexpired terms.
- 47 (5) Any member may be removed from the board by the Governor
- 48 after a hearing by the board * * *.

- 49 **SECTION 2.** Section 73-15-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 50 amended as follows:
- 51 73-15-11. (1) The members of the Mississippi Board of
- 52 Nursing shall meet annually and organize for the ensuing year by
- 53 election of one (1) of its members as president, one (1) as
- 54 secretary, and one (1) as treasurer. The \star \star representative of
- 55 consumers of health services may discuss and nominate but shall
- 56 not vote for officers nor hold office in such elections.
- 57 (2) The board shall meet at least once every four (4) months
- 58 for the purpose of transacting such business as may come before
- 59 the board. Any member who shall not attend two (2) consecutive
- 60 meetings of the board shall be subject to removal by the Governor.
- 61 The president of the board shall notify the Governor in writing
- 62 when any such member has failed to attend two (2) consecutive
- 63 regular meetings.
- 64 (3) Special meetings of the board may be held on call of the
- 65 president or upon call of any seven (7) members. A notice of
- 66 time, place and purpose of any special meeting shall be provided
- 67 by the executive director to all members of the board.
- 68 (4) On all matters the board shall function as a board of
- 69 thirteen (13) members, and seven (7) members, including at least
- 70 three (3) registered nurses and two (2) practical nurses, shall
- 71 constitute a quorum. In any case, the affirmative vote of a
- 72 majority of the members present and participating shall be
- 73 necessary to take action. In all cases pertaining to practical

- 74 nursing, such majority must include the affirmative vote of at
- 75 least one (1) of the practical nurse members of the board.
- 76 (5) The board shall hold not less than two (2) examinations
- 77 each year for registered nurses and not less than two (2) each
- 78 year for licensed practical nurses, at such times and places as
- 79 the board may determine.
- 80 (6) Each member of the board shall receive a per diem
- 81 compensation as provided in Section 25-3-69 for attendance at
- 82 board meetings, together with necessary travel and other expenses
- 83 incurred in the discharge of his or her duties as a board member.
- SECTION 3. Section 73-15-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 85 amended as follows:
- 86 73-15-15. (1) Each board member shall be a citizen of the
- 87 United States, a resident of the State of Mississippi, and shall
- 88 before entering upon duties of said office take the oath
- 89 prescribed by Section 268 of the Constitution of the State of
- 90 Mississippi and file same with the office of the secretary of
- 91 state who shall thereupon issue such person so appointed a
- 92 certificate of appointment.
- 93 (2) Each registered nurse board member shall possess these
- 94 additional qualifications:
- 95 (a) Education graduation from an approved educational
- 96 program for the preparation of registered nurses;
- 97 (b) Experience have at least five (5) years of
- 98 nursing experience since graduation;

- 101 (d) Licensure be currently registered to practice as
 102 a registered nurse in the State of Mississippi.
- 103 (3) Each licensed practical nurse board member shall possess 104 these additional qualifications:
- 105 (a) Education graduation from an approved educational program for the preparation of licensed practical nurses;
- 107 (b) Experience have at least five (5) years of 108 nursing experience since graduation;
- 109 (c) Employment have been employed for at least the
 110 past three (3) years as a licensed practical nurse in Mississippi;
- 111 (d) Licensure be currently registered to practice as
 112 a licensed practical nurse in the State of Mississippi.

- SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2025.
