- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. (1) The following words shall have the following 8 meanings described herein:
- (a) "Law enforcement officer" means the same as defined 9
- 10 in Section 45-6-3, and includes any other person who has the
- authority of law to stop or otherwise detain a person if the 11
- 12 failure or refusal of the person to stop or be detained could
- 13 result in criminal penalties to the person.
- 14 "Stop" means any hinderance of a person's movement,
- 15 interruption of movement or form of detention by a law enforcement
- 16 officer for any reason including consensual or nonconsensual
- 17 searches of the person's body or property in the person's
- possession or control. 18

- 19 (2) When a law enforcement officer stops any person for any
- 20 reason, such law enforcement officer or officers, as applicable,
- 21 shall articulate the reason or reasons for such stop during the
- 22 time of the stop.
- 23 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 2025.
