HOUSE BILL NO. 620

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE LICENSED NURSE PRACTITIONERS AND 2 REGISTERED NURSES TO ADMINISTER FLUIDS CONTAINING VITAMINS FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING A PERSON'S IMMUNE HEALTH THROUGH INTRAVENOUS (IV) THERAPY IN A CLINICAL SETTING; TO PROVIDE THAT THERE IS NO 5 LIMIT ON THE NUMBER OF VITAMINS THAT MAY BE ADMINISTERED BY A NURSE PRACTITIONER OR REGISTERED NURSE AT ANY ONE TIME; TO PROVIDE 7 THAT THE VITAMINS ADMINISTERED BY A NURSE PRACTITIONER OR 8 REGISTERED NURSE DO NOT HAVE TO BE PREPARED BY A COMPOUND PHARMACY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- 11 SECTION 1. Nurse practitioners and registered nurses
- 12 licensed by the Mississippi Board of Nursing shall be authorized
- to administer fluids containing vitamins for the purpose of 13
- 14 improving a person's immune health through intravenous (IV)
- 15 therapy in a clinical setting. There is no limit on the number of
- 16 vitamins that may be administered through IV therapy by a nurse
- 17 practitioner or registered nurse at any one time, and the vitamins
- 18 administered through IV therapy by a nurse practitioner or
- 19 registered nurse do not have to be prepared by a compound
- 20 pharmacy.

- 21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after July 1, 2025.

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ST: Nurses; allow nurse practitioners and RNs to administer vitamins through IV therapy in a clinical setting.
