HOUSE BILL NO. 729

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE STUDENTS ENROLLED IN A HOMESCHOOL TO PARTICIPATE IN PUBLIC SCHOOL INTERSCHOLASTIC EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES; TO PRESCRIBE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A STUDENT ENROLLED IN A HOMESCHOOL TO PARTICIPATE IN INTERSCHOLASTIC EXTRACURRICULAR 5 ACTIVITIES; TO PROHIBIT DISCRIMINATION AGAINST HOMESCHOOL STUDENT SELECTION OR PARTICIPATION IN SUCH ACTIVITIES; TO PROVIDE THAT 7 PARTICIPATION IN AN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY IS A PRIVILEGE AND 8 NOT A RIGHT; TO AUTHORIZE SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO APPLY TO THE STATE 9 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING TO COVER THE COST 10 OF HOMESCHOOL STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN EXTRACURRICULAR 11 ACTIVITIES; TO REQUIRE HOMESCHOOL STUDENTS TO PAY THE SAME 12 PARTICIPATION OR ACTIVITY FEES AS PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS; TO 13 CREATE THE HOMESCHOOL EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY FUND WITHIN THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS 14 15 TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS FOR HOMESCHOOL STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN 16 EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 18 SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, the following words 19 and phrases have the meanings ascribed in this subsection unless 20 the context clearly indicates otherwise: 21 (a) "Homeschool" means a legitimate home instruction program as described under Section 37-13-91(3). 22 23 (b) "Interscholastic extracurricular activity" means

any school-authorized sport or activity sanctioned by the

Mississippi High School Activities Association.

26	(C)	"Appropriate	documentation"	means:

- 27 (i) The results of a nationally recognized
- 28 standardized test or its equivalent as determined by the State
- 29 Department of Education;
- 30 (ii) A portfolio of the student's school work from
- 31 the previous year demonstrating the student's proficiency
- 32 appropriate for the student's grade level, as determined in the
- 33 discretion of the school principal or counselor; or

- 38 (2) (a) A student enrolled in a homeschool is eligible to

- 43 student who leaves a public school during the school year is

- 48 (i) Pay any participation or activity fee in an

- 77 (c) In selecting the members of an interscholastic
- 78 extracurricular team, a public school shall not discriminate
- 79 against a student being educated in a homeschool who is eligible
- 80 to participate under this section.
- 81 (3) Participation in an interscholastic extracurricular
- 82 activity is a privilege and not a right. Nothing in this act
- 83 shall be interpreted to create a cause of action on behalf of a
- 84 student against a public school or public school district official
- 85 or against an interscholastic extracurricular activities
- 86 association.
- 87 (4) With respect to a homeschool student's education
- 88 program, nothing in this section shall be construed to permit an
- 89 agency of the state, a public school district or any other
- 90 governmental body to exercise control, regulatory authority or
- 91 supervision over a homeschool student or parent or person standing
- 92 in parental relation to a homeschool student beyond the control,
- 93 regulatory or supervision required to participate in league
- 94 activity.

- 96 of Education for additional funding to cover the cost of any

- 101 (c) The application must include the number of
 102 homeschool students participating in extracurricular activities in
 103 the prior school year, the activities in which the homeschool
 104 students participated, and such other information that is required
 105 by the department.
- 106 There is established a special fund within the (6) (a) 107 State Department of Education to be known as the "Homeschool 108 Extracurricular Activity Fund." A school district may apply for and receive funds under this subsection in the amount of Two 109 110 Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,250.00) for each homeschool student who participated in extracurricular activities in the 111 112 prior school year. The State Department of Education shall make 113 distributions from the Homeschool Extracurricular Activity Fund. 114 If at any time the fund is exhausted, disbursements must be made by the department from any other available funds that may be used, 115 116 in the determination of the department, for such purposes.
- 117 (b) This subsection shall not be construed to require a
 118 school district to request funding.
- 119 (c) The State Department of Education shall report
 120 disbursements made pursuant to this subsection to the Office of
 121 the State Auditor, on a form created by the Office of the State
 122 Auditor, on July 1, 2026, and every two (2) years thereafter.

123 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

124 and after July 1, 2025.
