- 9 person who is seeking employment by the State of Mississippi to
- 10 submit to and pass a drug test.
- 11 (2) The State Personnel Board shall adopt rules and
- 12 regulations governing the drug testing of prospective state
- 13 employees.
- 14 (3) The cost of a drug test required under this section must
- 15 be paid by the person who is being tested; however, the State
- 16 Personnel Board, in its discretion, may elect to pay for the cost
- 17 of the drug test on behalf of any prospective state employee.
- 18 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after July 1, 2025.
