HOUSE BILL NO. 807

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE DIVISION OF AUTISM SERVICES WITHIN
THE BUREAU OF INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES OF THE
STATE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH TO DEVELOP AND COORDINATE AUTISM
SERVICES FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER AND THEIR
FAMILIES; TO SPECIFY THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE DIVISION; TO
BRING FORWARD SECTION 41-4-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH
SPECIFIES THE DIVISIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT, FOR POSSIBLE AMENDMENT;
AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, the following terms
 11 shall be defined as provided in this subsection:
- 12 (a) "Autism spectrum disorder" or "ASD" shall be
- 13 defined by the current version of the Diagnostic and Statistical
- 14 Manual of Mental Disorders published by the American Psychiatric
- 15 Association.
- 16 (b) "Autism services" means services designed to meet
- 17 the needs of individuals with ASD across their lifespan, including
- 18 services selected in collaboration with the parents or quardians
- 19 of children with ASD or adults with ASD and services delivered in
- 20 inclusive environments, to the extent practical, and services that
- 21 are part of a coordinated system of care.

(c) "Coordinated	system of	care"	means	the	total
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- 23 statewide effort, inclusive of case management, that is directed
- 24 at meeting the needs of individuals with ASD and their families.
- 25 (2) There is an urgent and substantial need to develop and
- 26 implement a statewide comprehensive, coordinated,
- 27 multidisciplinary, interagency system of care for individuals with
- 28 autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and their families. To help
- 29 address that need, there is established the Division of Autism
- 30 Services within the Bureau of Intellectual and Developmental
- 31 Disabilities of the State Department of Mental Health to develop
- 32 and coordinate autism services for individuals with ASD and their
- 33 families.
- 34 (3) The Division of Autism Services, under the supervision
- 35 of the Director of the Bureau of Intellectual and Developmental
- 36 Disabilities, shall provide leadership in program development for
- 37 children and adults with ASD, including establishment of program
- 38 standards and coordination of program capacity. The Division of
- 39 Autism Services shall have the following powers and duties:
- 40 (a) To define the roles and responsibilities of the
- 41 division;
- 42 (b) To develop a long-term plan, reviewed annually, for
- 43 a comprehensive statewide coordinated system of care for
- 44 individuals with ASD, which, to the extent practicable, is derived
- 45 from scientific-based research and nationally recognized best
- 46 practices; and

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- 48 participation, and mutual sharing of information to facilitate
- 49 policy decisions and the implementation of a plan for a
- 50 comprehensive statewide system of care to individuals with ASD.
- 51 **SECTION 2.** Section 41-4-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 52 brought forward as follows:
- 53 41-4-5. There is created the State Department of Mental
- 54 Health, herein referred to as "department," which shall consist of
- 55 four (4) or more divisions, among them the Division of
- 56 Intellectual Disabilities, the Division of Alcohol and Drug
- 57 Misuse, the Division of Mental Health, and the Division of
- 58 Administration, Planning and Coordination, and such other
- 59 divisions as the board deems appropriate.
- 60 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 61 and after July 1, 2025.
