## HOUSE BILL NO. 810

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-3-95, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO

2 EXEMPT THE STATEWIDE COORDINATOR FOR JUNIOR RESERVE OFFICER

3 TRAINING CORPS (JROTC) EMPLOYED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF

4 EDUCATION FROM THE STATE PERSONNEL BOARD QUALIFICATION; TO MAKE

5 SUCH POSITION EQUIVALENT TO AN EDUCATOR PROGRAM

6 ADMINISTRATOR/SUPERVISOR WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT'S ORGANIZATIONAL

7 STRUCTURE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-3-95, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

10 amended as follows:

11 37-3-95. (1) Subject to the availability of funding for

12 such purpose, the State Superintendent of Public Education shall

13 employ within the State Department of Education or, in the

14 alternative, contract with the Mississippi Military Department for

15 a statewide coordinator for Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps

16 (JROTC) programs in the public schools. If employed by the State

17 Department of Education, the JROTC statewide coordinator must be

18 an active or retired member of the military and must meet any

19 additional qualifications that may be established for the position

20 by the State Superintendent of Public Education \* \* \* and shall

- 23 The following are the powers and duties of the JROTC
- statewide coordinator: 24
- 25 To coordinate training of new JROTC instructors and
- 26 continuing education programs for certified instructors;
- 27 To facilitate communication between JROTC programs (b)
- 28 in the various public schools;
- 29 To assist in organizing competitions among JROTC (C)
- 30 units from different high schools;
- 31 (d) To assist in the development of the JROTC
- 32 curriculum;
- To compile information on scholarships available to 33 (e)
- JROTC participants and to solicit support for such scholarships; 34
- 35 To assist in establishing support groups for
- 36 parents of students participating in a JROTC program;
- 37 To solicit and accept financial support for JROTC (a)
- 38 programs from private sector donors;
- 39 To promote the involvement of JROTC units within (h)
- their local communities; 40
- 41 (i) To facilitate interaction between JROTC units and
- 42 the Mississippi National Guard and Mississippi Air National Guard;
- To promote, in general, the JROTC program in high 43
