HOUSE BILL NO. 867

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-42-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 DIRECT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO PROVIDE FOR A NURSE PRACTITIONER TO BE PRESENT AT EACH COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT FOR AT LEAST ONE DAY EACH WEEK IN ORDER TO PROVIDE PERSONS WITH 5 CONTRACEPTIVE SUPPLIES AND PRESCRIPTIONS FOR CONTRACEPTIVE SUPPLIES AT NO COST TO THE RECIPIENT; TO AMEND SECTION 41-42-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM TO THE PRECEDING PROVISION; 7 TO AMEND SECTION 41-42-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE 8 9 NURSE PRACTITIONERS TO PROVIDE CONTRACEPTIVE SUPPLIES AND 10 INFORMATION TO CERTAIN MINORS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 SECTION 1. Section 41-42-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 12 13 amended as follows: 41-42-5. (1) The State Board of Health is authorized to 14 15 receive and disburse such funds as may become available to it for family planning programs to any organization, public or private, 16 17 engaged in providing contraceptive procedures, supplies, and information. Any family planning program administered by the 18 board may be developed in consultation and coordination with other 19 20 family planning agencies in this state. The board is * * * authorized to adopt and promulgate 21
