5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI
6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be
7	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
8	Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Supervisors of
9	Humphreys County for the purpose of providing funding assistance
10	in Cost Share Needs for projects more specifically described in
11	Section 2 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending
12	June 30, 2026\$ 10,600,000.00
13	SECTION 2. The funding appropriated by this act is to
14	provide assistance in Cost Share Needs for projects necessary to
15	continue recovery efforts in response to the EF4 tornado that
16	devastated areas of Humphreys County on March 24, 2023, which
17	projects include:
18	(a) Existing debris removal (twenty-five percent (25%)
19	cost share for cleanup);

20	(b) Repairs to damaged roads;
21	(c) Replacement of county equipment;
22	(d) Construction of a new county barn and fire station;
23	(e) Restoration of housing;
24	(f) Emergency 911 interoperability upgrades; and
25	(g) A community development center.
26	SECTION 3. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
27	by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund
28	not otherwise appropriated upon warrants issued by the State
29	Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his or
30	her warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person,
31	officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
32	SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
33	and after July 1, 2025.
