HOUSE BILL NO. 1079

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-5-931, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT
WITH THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF FORREST COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, FOR
THE HOUSING OF STATE INMATES IN ITS CORRECTIONAL FACILITY; AND FOR
RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 47-5-931, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 47-5-931. (1) The Department of Corrections, in its
- 10 discretion, may contract with the board of supervisors of one or
- 11 more counties or with a regional facility operated by one or more
- 12 counties, to provide for housing, care and control of offenders
- 13 who are in the custody of the State of Mississippi. Any facility
- 14 owned or leased by a county or counties for this purpose shall be
- 15 designed, constructed, operated and maintained in accordance with
- 16 American Correctional Association standards, and shall comply with
- 17 all constitutional standards of the United States and the State of
- 18 Mississippi, and with all court orders that may now or hereinafter
- 19 be applicable to the facility. If the Department of Corrections

- 20 contracts with more than one (1) county to house state offenders
- 21 in county correctional facilities, excluding a regional facility,
- 22 then the first of such facilities shall be constructed in Sharkey
- 23 County and the second of such facilities shall be constructed in
- 24 Jefferson County.
- 25 (2) The Department of Corrections shall contract with the
- 26 board of supervisors of the following counties to house state
- 27 inmates in regional facilities: (a) Marion and Walthall Counties;
- 28 (b) Carroll and Montgomery Counties; (c) Stone and Pearl River
- 29 Counties; (d) Winston and Choctaw Counties; (e) Kemper and Neshoba
- 30 Counties; (f) Alcorn County and any contiguous county in which
- 31 there is located an unapproved jail; (g) Yazoo County and any
- 32 contiguous county in which there is located an unapproved jail;
- 33 (h) Chickasaw County and any contiguous county in which there is
- 34 located an unapproved jail; (i) George and Greene Counties and any
- 35 contiguous county in which there is located an unapproved jail;
- 36 (j) Washington County and any contiquous county in which there is
- 37 located an unapproved jail; (k) Hinds County and any contiguous
- 38 county in which there is located an unapproved jail; (1) Leake
- 39 County and any contiquous county in which there is located an
- 40 unapproved jail; (m) Issaquena County and any contiguous county in
- 41 which there is located an unapproved jail; (n) Jefferson County
- 42 and any contiguous county in which there is located an unapproved
- 43 jail; (o) Franklin County and any contiguous county in which there
- 44 is located an unapproved jail; (p) Holmes County and any

- 45 contiguous county in which there is located an unapproved
- 46 jail; * * * (q) Bolivar County and any contiguous county in which
- 47 there is located an unapproved jail; and (r) Forrest County. The
- 48 Department of Corrections shall decide the order of priority of
- 49 the counties listed in this subsection with which it will contract
- 50 for the housing of state inmates. For the purposes of this
- 51 subsection, the term "unapproved jail" means any jail that the
- 52 local grand jury determines should be condemned or has found to be
- of substandard condition or in need of substantial repair or
- 54 reconstruction.
- 55 (3) In addition to the offenders authorized to be housed
- 56 under subsection (1) of this section, the Department of
- 57 Corrections may contract with any regional facility to provide for
- 58 housing, care and control of not more than seventy-five (75)
- 59 additional offenders who are in the custody of the State of
- 60 Mississippi.
- 61 (4) The Governor and the Commissioner of Corrections are
- 62 authorized to increase administratively the number of offenders
- 63 who are in the custody of the State of Mississippi that can be
- 64 placed in regional correctional facilities.
- 65 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 66 and after July 1, 2025.
