252	whole or in part, such suspension shall not affect the state
253	assessment under this section. No state assessment imposed under
254	the provisions of this section may be suspended or reduced by the
255	court.
256	(10) (a) After a determination by the court of the amount
257	due, it shall be the duty of the clerk of the court to promptly
258	collect all state assessments imposed under the provisions of this
259	section. The state assessments imposed under the provisions of
260	this section may not be paid by personal check.
261	(b) It shall be the duty of the chancery clerk of each
262	county to deposit all state assessments collected in the circuit,
263	county and justice courts in the county on a monthly basis with
264	the State Treasurer pursuant to appropriate procedures established
265	by the State Auditor. The chancery clerk shall make a monthly
266	lump-sum deposit of the total state assessments collected in the
267	circuit, county and justice courts in the county under this

section, and shall report to the Department of Finance and

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Administration the total number of violations under each subsection for which state assessments were collected in the circuit, county and justice courts in the county during that month.

- 273 It shall be the duty of the municipal clerk of each 274 municipality to deposit all the state assessments collected in the 275 municipal court in the municipality on a monthly basis with the 276 State Treasurer pursuant to appropriate procedures established by 277 the State Auditor. The municipal clerk shall make a monthly lump-sum deposit of the total state assessments collected in the 278 279 municipal court in the municipality under this section, and shall 280 report to the Department of Finance and Administration the total 281 number of violations under each subsection for which state 282 assessments were collected in the municipal court in the 283 municipality during that month.
- 284 (11) It shall be the duty of the Department of Finance and
 285 Administration to deposit on a monthly basis all state assessments
 286 into the State General Fund or proper special fund in the State
 287 Treasury. The Department of Finance and Administration shall
 288 issue regulations providing for the proper allocation of these
 289 funds.
- 290 (12) The State Auditor shall establish by regulation 291 procedures for refunds of state assessments, including refunds 292 associated with assessments imposed before July 1, 1990, and 293 refunds after appeals in which the defendant's conviction is

294	reversed. The Auditor shall provide in the regulations for
295	certification of eligibility for refunds and may require the
296	defendant seeking a refund to submit a verified copy of a court
297	order or abstract by which the defendant is entitled to a refund.
298	All refunds of state assessments shall be made in accordance with
299	the procedures established by the Auditor.
300	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
301	and after July 1 2025
