HOUSE BILL NO. 1131

1 AN ACT TO BRING FORWARD SECTION 10 OF CHAPTER 524, LAWS OF  
2 2024, WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS FROM THE 2024  
3 LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS FUND, FOR THE PURPOSE OF POSSIBLE  
4 AMENDMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 10 of Chapter 524, Laws of 2024, is  
7 brought forward as follows:

8 Section 10. Monies transferred pursuant to Sections 1 and 2  
9 of this act into the 2024 Local Improvements Projects Fund shall  
10 be disbursed by the Department of Finance and Administration,  
11 pursuant to the authority to spend those monies granted by an  
12 appropriation bill passed separately during the 2024 Regular  
13 Session, as follows:
