The State of Mississippi shall not be required to comply with or recognize any mandates, orders, laws, decrees, or 9 10 directives handed down by any organization, commission or other 11 entity that is not a state or federally elected official or body, or a United States citizen appointed by a state or federally 12 13 elected official or body, or a United States citizen acting solely

as a nominee of a state or federally elected official or body,
