## HOUSE BILL NO. 1329

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 43-12-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
  TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES MUST REQUIRE
  PERSONS WHO ARE RECEIVING SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE
  PROGRAM BENEFITS WHO ARE EIGHTEEN TO FIFTY-NINE YEARS OF AGE, DO
  NOT HAVE CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN IN THEIR HOME, DO NOT
  QUALIFY FOR AN EXEMPTION, AND ARE DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO
  BE ELIGIBLE, TO PARTICIPATE IN AN EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING PROGRAM;
  AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 **SECTION 1.** Section 43-12-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 11 amended as follows:
- 12 43-12-19. Work requirements. (1) The Department of Human
- 13 Services shall not seek, apply for, accept or renew any waiver of
- 14 requirements established under 7 USC Section 2015(o), except
- 15 during a formal state or federal declaration of a natural
- 16 disaster.
- 17 (2) Unless prohibited by the federal government, the
- 18 Department of Human Services must require a person who is
- 19 receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program benefits who:
- 20 (a) is eighteen (18) to fifty-nine (59) years of age, inclusive;
- 21 (b) does not have children under the age of eighteen (18) in his

- 22 or her home; (c) does not qualify for an exemption; and (d) is
- 23 determined by the department to be eligible, to participate in an
- 24 employment and training program, as provided in 7 USC Section
- 25 2015 (d).
- 26 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2025.
