HOUSE BILL NO. 1340

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-37-39, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE AN AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE TO A VIOLATION FOR MACHINE GUN CONVERSION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 97-37-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 97-37-39. (1) (a) Any person who manufactures, possesses,
- 8 or uses a machine gun conversion device * * * shall be guilty of a
- 9 felony.
- 10 (b) For purposes of this section, the following terms
- 11 shall have the meanings described herein:
- 12 (i) "Machine gun conversion" means a device that
- 13 is designed, made and intended to convert a semi-automatic firearm
- 14 into a machine gun. The term "machine gun conversion" does not
- 15 include any semi-automatic firearm or any device designed only to
- 16 aid the operator of a semi-automatic firearm to discharge the
- 17 firearm more accurately or to pull the trigger more quickly as

- 18 long as the operator must still function the trigger of the
- 19 firearm for each shot fired.
- 20 (ii) Machine gun means any weapon which shoots, is
- 21 designed to shoot, or can be readily restored to shoot,
- 22 automatically more than one (1) shot without manual reloading, by
- 23 a single function of the trigger.
- 24 (2) (a) Any person convicted of a first offense in
- 25 violation of this act shall be guilty of a felony, and shall be
- 26 sentenced to imprisonment for a term of not more than ten (10)
- 27 years, fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), or
- 28 both.
- 29 (b) It shall be an affirmative defense for a violation
- 30 of this section that the person is otherwise authorized by federal
- 31 law to manufacture, possess or use a machine gun conversion
- 32 device.
- 33 (3) A person convicted of a second or subsequent offense
- 34 shall be charged with a felony under this act and shall be
- 35 sentenced to imprisonment for a term of not more than fifteen (15)
- 36 years, fined not more than Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00),
- 37 or both.
- 38 (4) This section shall be known as the "Jeremy Todd Malone
- 39 Law."
- 40 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 41 and after July 1, 2025.
