## HOUSE BILL NO. 1397

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-7-37.1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT PROBATION, POST-RELEASE SUPERVISION OR SUSPENSION OF SENTENCE MAY BE REVOKED PRIOR TO ITS COMMENCEMENT IF A NEW FELONY CRIME IS COMMITTED, BY AN INDIVIDUAL, PRIOR TO ITS COMMENCEMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 47-7-37.1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 47-7-37.1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
- 10 contrary, if a court finds by a preponderance of the evidence,
- 11 that a probationer or a person under post-release supervision has
- 12 committed a felony or absconded, the court may revoke his or her
- 13 probation and impose any or all of the sentence. For purposes of
- 14 this section, "absconding from supervision" means the failure of a
- 15 probationer to report to his supervising officer for six (6) or
- 16 more consecutive months.
- 17 The probation, post-release supervision or suspension of
- 18 sentence may also be revoked of anyone who is sentenced to
- 19 probation, post-release supervision or suspension of sentence, and

- 20 he or she commits a new felony crime before his or her probation,
- 21 post-release supervision or suspension of sentence has commenced,
- 22 the same as if it had already commenced.
- 23 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 2025.
