HOUSE BILL NO. 1415

- AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 73-15-71, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO TRANSFER THE ADMINISTRATION OF CERTIFICATION OF CERTIFIED NURSE AIDES (CNAS) FROM THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO THE MISSISSIPPI BOARD OF NURSING; TO PRESCRIBE THE MINIMUM DUTIES OF THE BOARD FOR THE CERTIFICATION PROCESS; TO DIRECT THE STATE TREASURER TO TRANSFER TO THE BOARD THE BALANCE OF ANY FUNDS OF THE DEPARTMENT THAT WERE USED FOR ADMINISTERING THE CERTIFICATION OF CNAS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 **SECTION 1.** The following shall be codified as Section
- 11 73-15-71, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 12 73-15-71. (1) From and after July 1, 2026, the
- 13 certification of certified nurse aides (CNAs) shall be

- 14 administered by the Mississippi Board of Nursing instead of the
- 15 State Department of Health. The duties of the board for the
- 16 certification process shall include, but not be limited to, the
- 17 following:
- 18 (a) Prescribe the requirements for certification and
- 19 recertification of nurse aides;
- 20 (b) Approve training courses for persons to be eligible
- 21 to take the certification examination;

(c) Administer the certification examination	or

- 23 contract with an administrator to develop, schedule, administer,
- 24 score and report the results of the certification examination;
- 25 (d) Issue certifications and renewals of certifications
- 26 for nurse aides; and
- 27 (e) Maintaining the Mississippi certified nurse aide
- 28 registry.
- 29 (2) The Mississippi Board of Nursing is authorized to
- 30 promulgate and enforce such rules, regulations and standards as
- 31 needed to carry out the provisions of this section.
- 32 (3) The Mississippi Board of Nursing shall not increase the
- 33 amount of the fees charged for applications, examinations,
- 34 issuance of certification and renewals of certifications for a
- 35 period of two (2) years after the effective date of this act.
- 36 **SECTION 2.** Any position or positions at the State Department
- 37 of Health whose duties are substantially involved with the
- 38 administration of certification of CNAs shall be transferred to
- 39 the Mississippi Board of Nursing.
- 40 **SECTION 3.** On July 1, 2026, the State Treasurer, in
- 41 conjunction with the State Fiscal Officer, shall transfer the
- 42 balance of any funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the
- 43 State Department of Health on June 30, 2026, that were used by the
- 44 department for administering of the certification of certified
- 45 nurse aides, into a special fund to the credit of the Mississippi
- 46 Board of Nursing, which shall be used by the board, upon

- 47 appropriation by the Legislature, for administering of the
- 48 certification of certified nurse aides.
- 49 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 50 and after July 1, 2026.
