- 13 drugs on behalf of the covered entity unless such receipt is
- 14 prohibited by the United States Department of Health and Human

- 16 (2) A manufacturer * * * shall not interfere with a pharmacy
- 17 contracted with a 340B entity.
- 18 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after July 1, 2025.
