HOUSE BILL NO. 1472 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILD PROTECTION
SERVICES SHALL EXPEND THOSE FEDERAL FUNDS THAT IT ADMINISTERS ONLY
IN A MANNER AUTHORIZED BY THE APPLICABLE SOURCE OF FEDERAL FUNDS;
TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN EXPENSES THAT ARE ORDERED TO BE PAID BY A
YOUTH COURT FOR A CHILD IN CUSTODY SHALL NOT BE PAID BY THE
DEPARTMENT OF CHILD PROTECTION SERVICES UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY A
SOURCE OF FEDERAL FUNDS OR BY A SPECIFIC STATE APPROPRIATION FOR
SUCH SERVICES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
