5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be
7	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Opioid
8	Settlement Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State
9	Department of Mental Health for the purpose of funding the Peer
10	Helpers PLUS Program and Prevention Awareness for Total Health
11	(PATH) curriculum for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and
12	ending June 30, 2026\$ 4,000,000.00.
13	SECTION 2. The funds appropriated under Section 1 of this
14	act shall be appropriated from monies available in the Opioid
15	Settlement Fund created in Section 27-103-305, Mississippi Code of
16	1972, to the State Department of Mental Health for the
17	administration of the Peer Helpers PLUS Program and the Prevention
18	Awareness for Total Health (PATH) curriculum established in House
19	Bill No. 1399, 2025 Regular Session.

- 20 **SECTION 3.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
- 21 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Opioid Settlement
- 22 Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
- 23 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue the
- 24 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or
- 25 officers in the manner provided by law.
- 26 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2025.
