HOUSE BILL NO. 1692

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF 2 MENTAL HEALTH FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPANDING OUTPATIENT SERVICES AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES FOR FORMER INMATES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS WHO WERE DIAGNOSED WITH A MENTAL ILLNESS WHILE HOUSED 5 WITHIN A STATE CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND WHO ARE NO LONGER INCARCERATED WITHIN A 7 CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS, AS PROVIDED IN HOUSE BILL NO. , 2025 REGULAR SESSION, FOR THE 8 9 FISCAL YEAR 2026. 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be 12 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 13 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Department of Mental 14 Health for the purpose of expanding outpatient services and community-based services for former inmates of the Department of 15 Corrections who were diagnosed with a mental illness while housed 16 17 within a state correctional institution of the Department of 18 Corrections and who are no longer incarcerated within a 19 correctional institution of the Department of Corrections, as provided in House Bill No. , 2025 Regular Session, for the 20 21 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026

23	SECTION 2. The Department of Mental Health shall distribute
24	up to \$500,000.00 of the money appropriated in Section 1 of this
25	act among the community mental health centers to be used for the
26	same purpose described in Section 1, as provided in House Bill
27	No, 2025 Regular Session.
28	SECTION 3. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
29	by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund
30	not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
31	Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his or
32	her warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person,
33	officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
34	SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
35	and after July 1, 2025.
