1       AN ACT MAKING A REAPPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE  
2   AND ADMINISTRATION TO REAUTHORIZE THE EXPENDITURE OF CAPITAL  
3   EXPENSES AND SPECIAL FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR  
4   CONSTRUCTION AND/OR REPAIR AND RENOVATION PROJECTS AT VARIOUS

6       BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

**SECTION 27.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2025.
