HOUSE BILL NO. 1770

1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI LIBRARY COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
7	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance
8	of the Mississippi Library Commission and for carrying out the
9	provisions of Section 39-3-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the
10	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026
11	\$ 10,946,838.00.
12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in
14	the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Library
15	Commission which is comprised of special source funds collected by
16	or otherwise available to the commission, for the purpose of
17	defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal year
18	beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026

19	\$ 4,863,028.00.
20	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
21	this act, the following positions are authorized:
22	AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:
23	Permanent: 48
24	Time-Limited: 1
25	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
26	responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal
27	Services for Fiscal Year 2027 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2026 funds
28	appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are
29	added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2026 budget by the Mississippi
30	Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's
31	personal services appropriation, which the State Personnel Board
32	shall publish. The agency's personal services appropriation may
33	consist of restricted funds for approved vacancies for Fiscal Year
34	2026 that may be utilized to fill vacant Fiscal Year 2025
35	headcount. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that
36	the funds provided for vacancies are used to increase headcount
37	and not for promotions, title changes, in-range salary adjustments
38	or any other mechanism for increasing salaries for current
39	employees. It is the Legislature's intention that no employee
40	salary falls below the minimum salary established by the
41	Mississippi State Personnel Board.
42	Additionally, the State Personnel Board shall determine and
43	publish the projected annualized payroll costs based on current

- 44 employees. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to
- 45 ensure that actual personnel expenditures for Fiscal Year 2026 do
- 46 not exceed the data provided by the Legislative Budget Office. If
- 47 the agency's Fiscal Year 2026 projected cost exceeds the
- 48 annualized costs, no salary actions shall be processed by the
- 49 State Personnel Board except for new hires determined to be
- 50 essential for the agency.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 52 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or
- 53 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 54 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 55 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 56 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 57 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 58 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 59 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 61 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for
- 62 salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are
- 63 withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 65 violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A
- 66 relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 67 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

- 68 **SECTION 4.** Funds to be distributed to eliqible public
- 69 library systems under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall
- 70 be paid quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December
- 71 31, March 31 and June 30.
- 72 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 73 Mississippi Library Commission shall maintain complete accounting
- 74 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 75 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 76 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 77 2025. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 78 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2027 shall be submitted to
- 79 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 80 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 81 during the Fiscal Year 2026 budget request process.
- 82 **SECTION 6.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 83 Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred
- 84 Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the
- 85 Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75
- 86 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 87 **SECTION 7.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Three
- 88 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) or so much thereof as
- 89 may be necessary, is derived from the Education Enhancement Fund
- 90 pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of
- 91 1972, for MAGNOLIA.

92	SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature	e that no
93	less than One Million Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Doll	lars
94	(\$1,350,000.00) shall be expended for the Magnolia Data	abase.
95	SECTION 9. In compliance with the "Mississippi Pe	erformance
96	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the i	intent of
97	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be	e utilized
98	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to	achieve the
99	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding	authorized,
100	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targe	eted

122	A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets
123	set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the
124	agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget
125	Committee for Fiscal Year 2027.
126	SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated herein, Four Million
127	Eight Hundred Two Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-nine Dollars
128	(\$4,802,939.00) is provided for the cost of health insurance for
129	all full-time library staff members in each public library in
130	Mississippi.
131	SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that
132	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
133	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
134	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
135	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
136	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
137	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
138	made without competitive bids.
139	SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
140	funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
141	Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency

142	shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
143	appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
144	or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
145	actions contrary to this provision.
146	SECTION 13. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
147	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
148	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
149	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
150	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
151	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
152	SECTION 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from
153	and after July 1, 2025.
