HOUSE BILL NO. 1875

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO FREDERICK KENYON
2 CLARK OF LEAKE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Frederick Kenyon Clark of Leake County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction for the crime of armed robbery in Attala County, on
8 September 10, 1998, for which he was sentenced to serve six (6)
9 years in the custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections.
10 He was released due to expiration of his sentence on
11 September 8, 2004. The Legislature is informed that he has since
12 conducted himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good
13 and lawful manner.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
15 and after its passage.
