HOUSE BILL NO. 1876

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO FELISHA TURNER OF DESOTO COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Felisha Turner of DeSoto County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her
- 7 conviction for the crime of embezzlement on March 22, 2007, in
- 8 Tunica County, Mississippi, for which she was sentenced to serve
- 9 three (3) years supervised probation under the Mississippi
- 10 Department of Corrections.
- 11 She was released from probation on August 23, 2016. The
- 12 Legislature is informed that she has since conducted herself as a
- 13 law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 15 and after its passage.
