HOUSE BILL NO. 1877

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO MICHAEL GRAY OF
2 PRENTISS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Michael Gray of Prentiss County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction for the crime of burglary larceny-residential on
8 October 10, 2005, in Prentiss County, for which he was sentenced
9 to serve five (5) years under the supervision of the Mississippi
10 Department of Corrections. On July 31, 2007, he violated his
11 probation and it was revoked. He was released to Earned Release
12 Supervision on August 27, 2008.

13 He was discharged on November 23, 2008. The Legislature is
14 informed that he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and
15 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
17 and after its passage.
