HOUSE BILL NO. 1918

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO GERALD LAIRD OF
2 JEFFERSON DAVIS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Gerald Laird of Jefferson Davis County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector on September 25,
7 2003, in Lauderdale County for the crime of robbery, for which he
8 was sentenced to serve five (5) years, and thirty-six (36) months
9 of supervised probation within the custody of the Mississippi
10 Department of Corrections. He was released to Earned Released
11 Supervision on November 5, 2005, and discharged from probation on
12 May 7, 2009.

13 The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted
14 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
15 lawful manner.

16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
17 and after its passage.
