HOUSE BILL NO. 1921

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF 2 STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING 3 FUNDING FOR THE REPAIR, RESTORATION, IMPROVEMENTS AND MAINTENANCE OF CAMPUS FACILITIES AT THE THREE HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGES AND 4 5 UNIVERSITIES (HBCUS) IN MISSISSIPPI, ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY, 6 JACKSON STATE UNIVERSITY AND MISSISSIPPI VALLEY STATE UNIVERSITY, 7 FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING UPON THE PASSAGE OF THIS ACT AND ENDING 8 JUNE 30, 2026. 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 10 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be 11 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 12 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning for the purpose of providing 13 14 funding for the repair, restoration, improvements and maintenance 15 of campus facilities at the three (3) Historically Black Colleges 16 and Universities (HBCUs) in Mississippi, Alcorn State University, Jackson State University and Mississippi Valley State University, 17 as provided in Section 2 of this act, for the period beginning 18 19 upon the passage of this act and ending June 30, 2026...... 20\$300,000.00

21	SECTION	2.	The	monev	appro	priated	bv	Section	1	of	this	act

- 22 shall be allocated in equal amounts of One Hundred Million Dollars
- 23 (\$100,000,000.00) to each university, which shall be used
- 24 specifically for the following purposes:
- 25 (a) Renovation and restoration of historic buildings
- 26 and campus structures;
- 27 (b) Upgrades to campus infrastructure, including
- 28 electrical, plumbing and HVAC systems;
- 29 (c) Improvements to student housing facilities;
- 30 (d) Development of modern academic spaces and
- 31 laboratories;
- 32 (e) Enhancement of campus safety and security systems;
- 33 (f) Environmental sustainability projects, including
- 34 energy efficiency initiatives; and
- 35 (g) Any other campus repairs deemed essential to the
- 36 improvement of educational facilities at the universities.
- 37 **SECTION 3.** As a condition of receiving the funds
- 38 appropriated by Section 1 of this act:
- 39 (a) Each university shall be responsible for developing
- 40 and submitting to the board of trustees a comprehensive plan
- 41 detailing the use of the university's allocated funds, which plan
- 42 must include, at a minimum, specific timelines for the repair and
- 43 restoration work and shall be subject to approval by the board of
- 44 trustees; and

45	(b) Each university shall provide an annual report to
46	the Legislature outlining the progress made on repairs and
47	restorations funded by Section 1 of this act, including detailed
48	accounting of expenditures and any project delays or challenges.
49	SECTION 4. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
50	by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund
51	not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
52	Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his or
53	her warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person,
54	officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
55	SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
56	and after its passage.
