HOUSE BILL NO. 1925

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO DUSTIN DARELL MILLS OF RANKIN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Dustin Darell Mills of Rankin County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction on December 15, 2008, for the crime of grand larceny,
- 8 in Rankin County, for which he was sentenced to serve five (5)
- 9 years under the supervision of the Mississippi Department of
- 10 Corrections. He was released on probation on November 13, 2009.
- 11 On February 19, 2013, he was convicted for the crime of grand
- 12 larceny, burglary-vehicle and burglary-nonresidential to serve
- 13 five (5) years and one (1) day in the custody of the Mississippi
- 14 Department of Corrections, the sentence to run concurrently with
- 15 each other and consecutively with another conviction.
- He was released on June 25, 2013, and discharged on July 1,
- 17 2015. The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted

- 18 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
- 19 lawful manner.
- 20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after its passage.
