HOUSE BILL NO. 1942

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO ELAINE GOUDY OF COVINGTON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Elaine Goudy of Covington County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her
- 7 conviction for the crime of arson along with two (2) counts for
- 8 transfer of cocaine on November 15, 1997, in Covington County,
- 9 Mississippi, for which she was sentenced to serve eight (8) years
- 10 on each count to run concurrently with five (5) years for arson in
- 11 the custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections.
- 12 She was sent to Earned Release Supervision on April 7, 2003.
- 13 Upon completion of all terms and conditions of her sentence, she
- 14 was discharged on February 28, 2004. The Legislature is informed
- 15 that she has since conducted herself as a law-abiding and
- 16 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after its passage.
