HOUSE BILL NO. 1967

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO TRACEY RICE OF LOWNDES COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Tracey Rice of Lowndes County, Mississippi,
- 6 who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her conviction
- 7 for the crime of shoplifting in Lowndes County, on May 21, 2014,
- 8 for which she was sentenced to serve five (5) years probation
- 9 under the supervision of the Mississippi Department of
- 10 Corrections. Upon release to probation, she violated probation
- 11 and it was revoked. On September 2, 2016, she was charged for
- 12 possession of a controlled substance and sentenced to serve one
- 13 (1) year house arrest under the supervision of the Mississippi
- 14 Department of Corrections.
- 15 She was released to probation on April 27, 2017, and
- 16 discharged on July 14, 2017. The Legislature is informed that she
- 17 has since conducted herself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen
- 18 in a good and lawful manner.

- 19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after its passage.
