## HOUSE BILL NO. 1971

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO DEBRA DENISE THOMAS OF HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Debra Thomas of Hinds County, Mississippi,
- 6 who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her conviction
- 7 for the crime of shoplifting in Warren County, on August 31, 1998,
- 8 for which she was sentenced to serve three (3) years suspended and
- 9 five (5) years probation under the supervision of the Mississippi
- 10 Department of Corrections. During her release to probation, she
- 11 violated probation and it was revoked. On May 25, 2000, as a
- 12 result of her conviction for the crime of shoplifting, she was
- 13 sentenced to serve three (3) years in the custody of the
- 14 Mississippi Department of Corrections.
- 15 She was released from custody on July 22, 2002. The
- 16 Legislature is informed that she has since conducted herself as a
- 17 law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

- 18 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after its passage.
