HOUSE BILL NO. 1974

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO TRACEY RUSHING OF
2 HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Tracey Rushing of Hinds County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction for the crime of robbery in Hinds County, on August 8,
8 1984, for which he was sentenced to serve five (5) years, with two
9 (2) years suspended and three (3) years probation under the
10 supervision of the Mississippi Department of Corrections. On
11 February 10, 1993, he was convicted of compounding crime and
12 burglary-residential, and sentenced to serve three (3) years on
13 both counts in the custody of the Mississippi Department of
14 Corrections. He was sentenced February 21, 1996, in Hinds County
15 for the crime of compounding crime.

16 He was discharged on December 19, 1996. He was released to
17 probation on March 10, 1999, because of time served. The



18 Legislature is informed that he has since conducted himself as a
19 law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
21 and after its passage.
