## HOUSE BILL NO. 1975

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO QUINTIN PURNELL OF  
2 GRENADA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Quintin Purnell of Grenada County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his  
7 conviction for the crime of grand larceny on April 22, 1992, in  
8 Montgomery County, Mississippi, for which he was sentenced to  
9 serve sixty (60) months of supervised probation under the custody  
10 of the Mississippi Department of Corrections. Upon release from  
11 probation, he violated probation which resulted in revocation of  
12 the probation. He was convicted for the crime of grand larceny on  
13 October 18, 1993, in Montgomery County, for which he was sentenced  
14 to serve three (3) years in the custody of the Mississippi  
15 Department of Corrections and two (2) years release supervision.  
16 He was released from supervision on February 28, 1996, due to  
17 expiration of sentence. The Legislature is informed that he has



18 since conducted himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in  
19 a good and lawful manner.

20       **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
21 and after its passage.
