## HOUSE BILL NO. 1981

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO OMAR TRAVIS OF HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Omar Travis of Hinds County, Mississippi,
- 6 who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his conviction
- 7 on March 6, 1991, in Hinds County on the charge of
- 8 burglary-residential with CT. I, II, III, IV running concurrent to
- 9 each other, and sentenced to serve five (5) years within the
- 10 custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections.
- On February 2, 2009, he was convicted of an out-of-state
- 12 charge of burglary, for which he was sentenced to probation for
- 13 four (4) years, nine (9) months and two (2) days. On March 14,
- 14 2016, he was convicted in Rankin County Circuit Court for
- 15 receiving stolen property, for which he was sentenced to ten (10)
- 16 years to serve within the Mississippi Department of Corrections.
- 17 He was released to parole on February 14, 2018, and was discharged
- 18 from probation on February 1, 2021.

- The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted
- 20 himself as a law-abiding citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after its passage.
