HOUSE BILL NO. 1990

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO DERRICK DUJMOV OF
2 HARRISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Derrick Dujmov of Harrison County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction for the crime of grand larceny and possession of a
8 controlled substance in Harrison County, on September 8, 2011, for
9 which he was sentenced to two (2) years post supervised probation
10 and three (3) years in the custody of the Mississippi Department
11 of Corrections. He was released to parole on August 27, 2013, and
12 discharged from probation on August 14, 2024.

13 On October 1, 2018, he was sentenced to serve two (2) years
14 and six (6) months to run consecutively for the crime of delivery
15 of a controlled substance.

16 He was released to parole on June 10, 2019. He was
17 discharged from probation on February 5, 2022. The Legislature is



18 informed that he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and
19 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
21 and after its passage.
