HOUSE BILL NO. 1998

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO APRIL PACE-BROOKS
2 OF COAHOMA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to April Pace-Brooks of Coahoma County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her
7 conviction for the crime of embezzlement in Tunica County, on June
8 23, 2003, for which she was sentenced to serve sixty (60) months
9 on probation under the supervision of the Mississippi Department
10 of Corrections.

11 She was discharged from probation on June 23, 2008. The
12 Legislature is informed that she has since conducted herself as a
13 law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
15 and after its passage.
