HOUSE BILL NO. 4003

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JOHN HOWARD COOK OF LAMAR COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to John Howard Cook of Lamar County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction for the crime of grand larceny in Panola County, on
- 8 April 20, 1979, for which he was sentenced to serve sixty (60)
- 9 months probation under the custody of the Mississippi Department
- 10 of Corrections. He violated probation on February 18, 1980, it
- 11 was revoked and as a result of such revocation, he was sentenced
- 12 on February 18, 1980, to serve eleven (11) years in the
- 13 Mississippi Department of Corrections.
- 14 He was released on December 26, 1992. The Legislature is
- 15 informed that he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and
- 16 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after its passage.
