## HOUSE BILL NO. 4005

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO KENDRONIKUS POWELL  
2 OF HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Kendronikus Powell of Hinds County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his  
7 conviction for the crime of strong armed robbery in Hinds County,  
8 on September 20, 2013, for which he was sentenced to serve five  
9 (5) years in the custody of the Mississippi Department of  
10 Corrections. He was released on March 4, 2015, and discharged on  
11 September 9, 2015. He was sentenced on March 7, 2016, in Copiah  
12 County for the crime of possession of firearm by convicted felon  
13 for which he was sentenced to serve three (3) years in the custody  
14 of the Mississippi Department of Corrections.

15 He was released on December 6, 2016, and discharged on  
16 January 6, 2018. The Legislature is informed that he has since  
17 conducted himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good  
18 and lawful manner.



19           **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
20 and after its passage.
