HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 5

- 1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 2 241, MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890, TO PROVIDE THAT ONLY
- 3 CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES ARE ALLOWED THE OPPORTUNITY TO VOTE;
- AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendments to the Mississippi 6
- 7 Constitution of 1890 are proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 8 state:
- Amend Section 241, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, to read 9
- 10 as follows:
- "Section 241. Every inhabitant of this state, except idiots 11
- 12 and insane persons, who is a citizen of the United States of
- 13 America, eighteen (18) years old and upward, who has been a
- 14 resident of this state for * * * thirty (30) days, and for * * *
- thirty (30) days in the county in which he or she offers to vote, 15
- and for * * * thirty (30) days in the election precinct or in the 16
- 17 incorporated city or town in which he or she offers to vote, and
- who is duly registered as provided in this article, and who has 18
- 19 never been convicted of murder, rape, bribery, theft, arson,

- 20 obtaining money or goods under false pretense, perjury, forgery,
- 21 embezzlement or bigamy, is declared to be a qualified elector who
- 22 may vote in an election for state or local office or at a state
- 23 wide or local referendum, except that he or she shall be qualified
- 24 to vote for President and Vice President of the United States if
- 25 he or she meets the requirements established by Congress therefor
- 26 and is otherwise a qualified elector."
- 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment shall be
- 28 submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors at
- 29 an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday
- 30 of November 2026, as provided by Section 273 of the Constitution
- 31 and by general law.
- 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed
- 33 amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
- 34 constitutional amendment provides that only citizens of the United
- 35 States are allowed the opportunity to vote.
