## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 7

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIFE AND LEGACY OF  
2 OFFICER TROY FLOYD, AND EXPRESSING DEEPEST SYMPATHY TO HIS FAMILY  
3 AND FRIENDS UPON HIS PASSING.

4 WHEREAS, it is written in Ecclesiastes 3:1 that "To  
5 everything there is a season, and a time for every purpose under  
6 the Heaven," and as such, on Thursday, August 8, 2024, the  
7 immaculate author and finisher of our soul's destiny summoned the  
8 mortal presence of dearly beloved, Officer Troy Floyd, of the  
9 Summit Police Department, in Summit, Mississippi, to eternal rest,  
10 rendering great sorrow and loss to his family, friends and  
11 community; and

12 WHEREAS, Officer Floyd was an exemplary member of the Summit  
13 Police Department, demonstrating unwavering commitment, courage,  
14 and integrity in his role as a law enforcement officer, and  
15 embodying the core values of justice and selflessness throughout  
16 his career; and

17 WHEREAS, a native son of Lincoln County, Officer Floyd was a  
18 graduate of Brookhaven High School, Class of 1993, and lived in



19 the Clear Branch community, and his strong sense of family,  
20 community, and service to others was rooted in his upbringing and  
21 remained a guiding force throughout his life and career; and

22 WHEREAS, Officer Floyd's remarkable 28-year career in law  
23 enforcement included service in multiple capacities, including  
24 Deputy Sheriff with the Copiah, Lawrence, Lincoln, and Pike County  
25 Sheriff's Offices, as well as a Parole Agent with the Mississippi  
26 Department of Corrections; and

27 WHEREAS, additionally, Officer Floyd also served as a  
28 dispatcher and jailer for the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office, and  
29 with distinction in the Summit and Wesson Police Departments, and  
30 in every role, he demonstrated an unwavering commitment to  
31 protecting his community, upholding the law, and serving with  
32 integrity and honor; and

33 WHEREAS, on Thursday, August 8, 2024, Officer Floyd  
34 tragically lost his life in the line of duty, marking the end of  
35 his watch, and his sacrifice leaves a lasting legacy of valor,  
36 duty and service that will continue to inspire the community he  
37 served and loved; and

38 WHEREAS, Officer Floyd's passing represents an immeasurable  
39 loss to his family, friends, and the entire law enforcement  
40 community, and the Town of Summit will forever cherish his memory  
41 and the profound impact of his dedication and bravery; and

42 WHEREAS, Officer Floyd is survived by his beloved wife, Mrs.  
43 Sage Floyd, and his children, Raiden Floyd and Carlyanna



Nicholson, who mourn the loss of a devoted husband, father, and protector, and their strength and courage during this time of grief serve as an inspiration to all; and

WHEREAS, a testament to the power of faith in action, not only in his personal life but within the realm of law enforcement, Officer Floyd was grounded in his belief in God, and he approached his duties with a profound sense of purpose, tackling each day as a divine assignment from the Lord to serve and protect his community; and

WHEREAS, Officer Floyd drew strength from prayer, seeking guidance and wisdom to navigate situations with grace and integrity, and he could be witnessing of God's love for you and quoting scriptures while he was putting you in hand cuffs, emphasizing the importance of forgiveness and redemption; and

WHEREAS, Officer Floyd's faith allowed him to approach even the most challenging encounters with compassion and understanding, and by embodying the principles of faith, love and justice, he not only upheld the law but also inspired those around him to reflect on their own values, demonstrating that a Godly life can profoundly impact both personal and professional lives; and

77 THEREIN, That we honor Officer Troy Floyd for his selfless  
78 service, ultimate sacrifice, and the heroism that marked his  
79 career, and express deepest sympathy to his family, friends and  
80 colleagues upon his passing.
