HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 54

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION CALLING UPON THE UNITED STATES
CONGRESS TO PASS H.R. 589, 119TH CONGRESS (2025), AND S. 223,
119TH CONGRESS (2025), REPEALING THE FACE (FREEDOM OF ACCESS TO
CLINIC ENTRANCES) ACT AND COMMENDING PRESIDENT TRUMP FOR ISSUING
PRESIDENTIAL PARDONS TO 23 PRO-LIFE AMERICANS UNJUSTLY CONVICTED
THEREUNDER.

- 7 WHEREAS, the FACE Act (Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances
- 8 Act of 1994), 18 USC Section 248, was enacted by the United States
- 9 Congress and signed into law by President Bill Clinton in 1994 to
- 10 prohibit individuals from interfering with access to so-called
- 11 "reproductive health services," which include both abortion
- 12 facilities and pregnancy resource centers; and
- 13 WHEREAS, first-time FACE Act offenders face a penalty of up
- 14 to 12 months in jail and a \$15,000 fine, and repeat offenders can
- 15 receive up to three years of jail time and \$25,000 in fines; and
- 16 WHEREAS, according to World magazine, since a draft Supreme
- 17 Court opinion overturning Roe v. Wade was leaked in the Dobbs v.
- 18 Jackson Women's Health Center case in early May 2022, "The DOJ
- 19 began pairing standard FACE Act indictments with charges of

- 20 'conspiracy against rights,'" which carries penalties of up to a
- 21 "10-year prison sentence and its own fines"; and
- 22 WHEREAS, according to a report updated November 12, 2024, by
- 23 Catholic Vote, since the Dobbs' leak, at least 95 pregnancy
- 24 resource centers and pro-life groups have been attacked and
- 25 vandalized; and
- 26 WHEREAS, according to the Family Research Council, in the
- 27 year following that leak, at least 38 "churches across the country
- 28 have been firebombed, smashed, ransacked or vandalized with
- 29 pro-abortion graffiti and threatening messages," and there were at
- 30 least 23 "'other incidents' in which pro-abortion protesters were
- 31 arrested or pro-life individuals were physically attacked"; and
- 32 WHEREAS, according to an October 20, 2022, Fox News Digital
- 33 report, although radical left wing pro-abortion group Jane's
- 34 Revenge had claimed credit for more than a dozen attacks on
- 35 churches or pregnancy resource centers, "not a single member of
- 36 the underground group has been arrested"; and
- 37 WHEREAS, according to a May 12, 2022, report by the Wisconsin
- 38 State Journal, Jane's Revenge proclaimed it was at "war" with
- 39 pro-life groups, demanded "the disbanding of all anti-choice
- 40 establishments" and said the first attack was "only a warning";
- 41 and
- WHEREAS, despite the numerous serious attacks and threats
- 43 upon the pro-life community, according to Catholic Vote's data
- 44 updated November 11, 2024, there have been only five reported

- 45 arrests in connection with the attacks on the pro-life community;
- 46 and
- 47 WHEREAS, despite the numerous serious attacks and threats
- 48 against the pro-life community, according to an October 11, 2024,
- 49 article revised November 11, 2024, by the Alliance Defending
- 50 Freedom, "After the U.S. Supreme Court overturned Roe v. Wade in
- June 2022, the Biden administration began a campaign to promote
- 52 abortion nationwide" and the Biden Department of Justice (DOJ)
- 53 "brought at least 26 charges against pro-life individuals under
- 54 the FACE Act in 2022," but brought zero prosecutions against
- 55 "abortion activists who obstructed or vandalized pro-life
- 56 pregnancy centers in the wake of the Dobbs' decision that year";
- 57 and
- 58 WHEREAS, according to the aforementioned Alliance Defending
- 59 Freedom article, in October 2021, devout Christian Mark Houck was
- 60 praying with his son outside a Philadelphia, Pennsylvania,
- 61 abortion clinic when a Planned Parenthood escort repeatedly "got
- 62 in the face of Houck and his son" and made vulgar comments,
- 63 leading Houck to push the Planned Parenthood escort to get him
- 64 away from his son; and
- 65 WHEREAS, the aforementioned Alliance Defending Freedom
- 66 article further stated that state and local authorities brought no
- 67 charges against Houck, but the Biden Department of Justice did so
- 68 and, despite Houck's offer to turn himself in, "The FBI sent
- 69 'twenty heavily armed federal agents' to Houck's house in the

- 70 early morning hours, pointed at least five guns at him, his wife,
- 71 and his children, and then arrested him," yet it took a federal
- 72 jury less than three hours to find Houck not guilty of the charges
- 73 brought against him; and
- 74 WHEREAS, in another example of the Biden Administration's
- 75 persecution of the pro-life community, according to his written
- 76 testimony submitted December 18, 2024, to a subcommittee of the
- 77 United States House of Representatives Judiciary Committee, and
- 78 further, as reported by the National Catholic Register, father of
- 79 11 and small business owner, Paul Vaughn, was arrested in the
- 80 early morning hours at his home at gunpoint by an FBI swat team,
- 81 to the horror of his wife and seven of his children who were home,
- 82 all for merely praying outside an abortion clinic, after which
- 83 Vaughn was subjected to a lengthy prosecution and federal trial
- 84 and sentenced to three years of supervised release, even though
- 85 the lead negotiator for the local police department, who Vaughn
- 86 interacted with on the day of the alleged "crime," testified on
- 87 his behalf at the trial and video evidence showed Vaughn had not
- 88 blocked any facility entrances; and
- 89 WHEREAS, by his own public account, as broadcast by the
- 90 American Family Association (AFA), emergency room physician,
- 91 pastor, and father of 13, Dr. Coleman Boyd was put under felony
- 92 indictment under the FACE Act, paired with felony conspiracy
- 93 charges, forced to give up his firearms and placed under travel
- 94 restrictions blocking international mission work, as if he were a

95 terrorist, and, according to an article in Zenit Magazine, 96 "sentenced to six months of house arrest, five years of probation, 97 and a \$110,000 fine," before losing his job as a result of his 98 sentencing; and 99 WHEREAS, according to an article in The Daily Signal, 100 89-year-old concentration camp survivor, Eva Edl, faced over a 101 decade in prison and received three years of probation for her 102 nonviolent protest of the same destruction of human life she saw 103 in her youth at a communist death camp; and 104 WHEREAS, according to an article by the National Catholic 105 Register, in yet another example of the Biden administration's 106 abuse of power using the FACE Act, Bevelyn Beatty Williams, a 107 33-year-old pro-life activist, was sentenced to three and one-half 108 years in prison after her protest at an abortion facility, with 109 the judge mercilessly taking her away from her daughter, a 110 toddler, for that child's formative years; and 111 WHEREAS, President Trump has already pardoned or granted clemency to the aforementioned 23 pro-life activists, thereby 112 113 signaling his opposition to the FACE Act's many abuses; and 114 WHEREAS, this long train of abuses under the FACE Act has 115 demonstrated that the FACE Act has been weaponized and made a tool 116 of injustice and violation of law-abiding Americans'

constitutional rights, and has further demonstrated that the FACE

Act has been so irrevocably tainted by the Biden Administration's

politicized prosecutions and is so unavoidably subject to

120	prosecutorial abuse that United States Senator Mike Lee and
121	Representative Chip Roy have introduced H.R. 589 and S. 223 to
122	repeal the FACE Act, in support of which Senator Lee stated that
123	"the Biden DOJ has weaponized this constitutionally suspect law
124	against pro-life sidewalk counselors while failing to protect
125	pregnancy centers and churches from violent attacks,"; and
126	WHEREAS, despite the FBI's and DOJ's blatant abuses of the
127	FACE Act and the scandalously historic number of pardons and
128	clemencies the Biden administration issued, including of his own
129	disgraced son, admitted felon Hunter Biden, whom he falsely
130	promised he would never pardon, President Biden provided no relief
131	to the pro-life Americans unjustly persecuted by his
132	administration for exercising their rights to free speech and
133	religious liberty in opposition to abortion:
