CONFERENCE (MACCC) CHAMPIONSHIP.

- 6 WHEREAS, the Northwest Mississippi Community College Rangers
- 7 Football Team, a powerhouse program under the phenomenal
- 8 leadership of Head Coach Benjy Parker, repeated history yet again
- 9 in 2024 with its continued demonstration of exceptional skill,
- 10 teamwork and determination throughout their incredible season; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Rangers finished the season with an impressive
- 12 10-2 overall record, securing their 12th Mississippi Association
- 13 of Community Colleges Conference (MACCC) championship title and
- 14 the team's third championship in the past five years; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Northwest earned the No. 4 spot in the final
- 16 National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Division I
- 17 Football Poll, marking the ninth time in the last 10 seasons that
- 18 the Rangers have finished with a national ranking; and

19 WHEREAS, the Rangers earned a bid to the NJCAA Division I 20 Football Playoffs for the third time in the last four seasons, showcasing the team's continued excellence on a national level; 21 22 and 23 WHEREAS, the team's success was powered by standout 24 performances, including sophomore running back D'mariun Perteet, who set a new program single season rushing record with 257 25 26 attempts and 1,360 yards and earned MACCC North Division Player of 27 the Year, NJCAA Offensive Player of the Week, and All-NJCAA Region 28 23 Player of the Year honors; and 29 WHEREAS, quarterback Zach Wilcke delivered consistent 30 leadership and improvement throughout the season, passing for 2,051 yards and 15 touchdowns, including a career-high 287 yards 31 32 in the MACCC semifinal victory; and 33 WHEREAS, the Rangers's defense was anchored by outstanding 34 players such as Fredd Adams, who recorded eight interceptions and 35 earned First Team All-MACCC North Division and All-NJCAA Region 23 honors, and defensive linemen Jaylon Johnson and D.J. Burgess, who 36 37 combined for key tackles, sacks and quarterback pressures; and 38 WHEREAS, Head Coach Benjy Parker was named MACCC North 39 Division Coach of the Year and All-NJCAA Region 23 Coach of the 40 Year, further solidifying his place as one of the most successful coaches in Northwest history with a career record of 75-21; and 41 42 WHEREAS, the coaching staff, including Offensive Coordinator

- 49 Northwest football program continue to be an academic stronghold
- 50 with recent recognitions by the NJCAA for the highest GPA in the
- 51 country and leading the state for many years in the classroom; and
- 52 WHEREAS, the Northwest football program continues to be a
- 53 source of pride for the college, its alumni, and the entire State
- of Mississippi, representing the values of dedication,
- 55 sportsmanship and excellence; and
- 56 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
- 57 and honor the achievements of student-athletes such as the
- 58 Northwest Mississippi Community College Rangers Football Team, who
- 59 have brought honor to their college, community and the entire
- 60 State of Mississippi:
