HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 11

- A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE RICH AND HISTORICAL LEGACY OF THE CITY OF VICKSBURG, MISSISSIPPI, AND CONGRATULATING THE CITY UPON
- 3 THE OCCASION OF ITS BICENTENNIAL ANNIVERSARY, ACKNOWLEDGING 200
- 4 YEARS OF HISTORY AND PROGRESS.
- 5 WHEREAS, incorporated on January 29, 1825, the City of
- 6 Vicksburg, Mississippi, celebrates its Bicentennial Anniversary on
- 7 January 29, 2025, marking 200 years of historical, cultural and
- 8 economic significance as a vital part of Mississippi's heritage;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, strategically located along the Mississippi River,
- 11 Vicksburg has played an integral role in the historical, economic,
- 12 and residential development of the state, quickly becoming a
- 13 center for commerce, agriculture, and transportation in the early
- 14 19th century; and
- 15 WHEREAS, in the 19th century, river travel along the
- 16 Mississippi was fraught with danger due to treacherous conditions,
- 17 prompting federal intervention with the passage of the Steamboat
- 18 Act of 1838, though the law proved difficult to enforce; and

19	WHEREAS, recognizing the need for enhanced transportation,
20	Vicksburg became a pioneering hub for railroads in Mississippi,
21	with the establishment of the Vicksburg and Clinton Railroad in
22	1831, later expanded into the Vicksburg and Meridian Railroad, the
23	first east-west rail line linking Memphis and New Orleans; and
24	WHEREAS, Vicksburg is renowned for its critical role in
25	American history, particularly as a focal point of the Civil War,
26	where the 1863 Siege of Vicksburg proved to be a turning point in
27	the Union's effort to control the Mississippi River; and
28	WHEREAS, following the surrender of Confederate forces on
29	July 4, 1863, the city endured hardship during Reconstruction but
30	emerged resilient, rebuilding its levee systems, reviving
31	agricultural production, and witnessing a rebirth of the steamboat
32	industry; and
33	WHEREAS, in 1899, the United States Congress established the
34	Vicksburg National Military Park, preserving the site of the
35	historic siege and serving as a national monument to those who
36	fought in the Civil War, with 17,000 Union soldiers, including
37	13,000 unknown, laid to rest within its grounds; and
38	WHEREAS, in 1873, the Army Corps of Engineers established a
39	permanent presence in Vicksburg, leading to the city's
40	long-standing prominence in river management and flood control
41	efforts, which remain vital to the region's economy and

infrastructure today; and

43	WHEREAS, the shifting course of the Mississippi River in 1876
44	threatened Vicksburg's economy, but through federal and local
45	efforts, including the Yazoo River Diversion Project, the city
46	re-established itself as a thriving river port and continued its
47	economic development into the 20th and 21st centuries; and
48	WHEREAS, today, Vicksburg stands as a vibrant city that
49	embraces its historical legacy while fostering economic growth,
50	cultural enrichment, and tourism, serving as a premier destination
51	for visitors seeking to explore its museums, historical landmarks,
52	and riverfront attractions; and
53	WHEREAS, on the occasion of its Bicentennial, the City of
54	Vicksburg, under the leadership of its Mayor and Board of
55	Aldermen, will celebrate 200 years of perseverance, progress and
56	contributions to the State of Mississippi and the nation; and
57	WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
58	recognize and honor municipalities such as Vicksburg, which have
59	played a pivotal role in shaping the history and culture of
60	Mississippi:
61	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
62	REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby
63	commend the rich and historical legacy of the City of Vicksburg,
64	congratulate the city upon the occasion of its Bicentennial
65	Anniversary, acknowledging 200 years of excellence, and extend
66	best wishes for continued prosperity in the years to come.
