- 24 header giving the Lady Commodores a 2-1 lead before Florence
- 25 equalized late in regulation; and
- 26 WHEREAS, despite Florence controlling much of the possession
- 27 and outshooting Lafayette 16-7, the Lady Commodores' defensive
- 28 unit, anchored by Rhea's outstanding goalkeeping, held strong,
- 29 setting the stage for their success in penalty kicks; and
- 30 WHEREAS, in the decisive shootout, Lafayette relied on its
- 31 preparation and confidence, with Caroline Perkins and Lizah
- 32 Holland converting critical penalty shots before Rhea's heroics
- 33 secured the championship; and
- 34 WHEREAS, the Lady Commodores completed their remarkable
- 35 season with an 18-7 overall record, a testament to their hard
- 36 work, perseverance and belief in one another; and
- 37 WHEREAS, throughout the season, the Lafayette High School
