- 3 CHARTERING AS AN OFFICIAL MEMBER OF ROTARY INTERNATIONAL.
- 4 WHEREAS, the Holly Springs Rotary Club, a distinguished
- 5 chapter of Rotary International, was founded on February 26, 1925,
- 6 and officially certified as a chartered member of Rotary
- 7 International on March 25, 1925, thereby marking a century of
- 8 unwavering dedication to service within Marshall County and
- 9 beyond; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Rotary Club is a nonpolitical and nonreligious
- 11 global organization committed to fostering peace, goodwill and
- 12 understanding through the collaboration of business, professional
- 13 and community leaders, boasting a worldwide membership of over 1.4
- 14 million Rotarians in more than 46,000 clubs; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the Holly Springs Rotary Club was initially
- 16 sponsored by the Memphis Rotary Club, with special representative
- 17 Dabney Crump, and had as its first president Lester G. Fant, along

- 18 with fellow founding officers and charter members who laid a
- 19 strong foundation for the club's future; and
- 20 WHEREAS, throughout its 100-year history, the Holly Springs
- 21 Rotary Club has upheld the motto "Service Above Self," by actively
- 22 participating in numerous civic and charitable initiatives,
- 23 including educational scholarships for local high school
- 24 graduates, support for the Crippled Children's Hospital in
- 25 Memphis, sponsorship of the Boy Scouts, community beautification
- 26 projects and international humanitarian efforts such as Rotary
- 27 International's "Polio Plus" campaign and the Mid-South Gift of
- 28 Life program, which provides life-saving medical procedures for
- 29 children in need; and
- 30 WHEREAS, the club has also played a pivotal role in youth
- 31 development and education by sponsoring the Rust College Rotaract
- 32 Club, organizing the annual ACT Prep Program, recognizing
- 33 exemplary students through the Student of the Month and
- 34 Extraordinary Effort Award programs and sponsoring students to
- 35 attend the Rotary Youth Leadership Academy (RYLA); and
- 36 WHEREAS, the Holly Springs Rotary Club has remained a
- 37 steadfast pillar in the community by supporting civic engagement,
- 38 disaster relief, city clean-ups and numerous outreach programs
- 39 aimed at fostering unity, economic growth and leadership
- 40 development; and
- 41 WHEREAS, in its century-long existence, the club has provided
- 42 outstanding leadership, including past and present presidents who

- 43 have steered its mission forward, such as the first female
- 44 Rotarian Lucy B. Carpenter, the first African-American Rotarian
- 45 Mayor Eddie L. Smith, and a distinguished group of Paul Harris
- 46 Fellows who have contributed significantly to Rotary's legacy; and
- WHEREAS, the club will celebrate this momentous milestone
- 48 with a Centennial Celebration appropriately themed, "A Century of
- 49 Service and Community," on March 22, 2025, at 940 Outdoor & Co.,
- 50 where Rotarians, community leaders and citizens will gather to
- 51 honor its rich history and continued commitment to service; and
- 52 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
- 53 recognize and honor organizations that exemplify a commitment to
- 54 service, leadership and community engagement, as has been
- 55 evidenced by the Holly Springs Rotary Club for the duration of its
- 56 century of service, dedication to humanitarian efforts and
- 57 commitment to improving the quality of life for citizens in
- 58 Mississippi and beyond:
